Redford Township will utilize the CDBG-R funds to support a broad range of housing & community development projects. Proposed are 9 activities using CDBG-R funds. All non-planning and administrative funds will either benefit low and moderate income persons or areas that are considered by HUD to be low and moderate income areas.

<b>Quarterly Activities/ Project Description</b>	<p>The Town Hall capital improvement project was completed this reporting period and another two projects were started utilizing CDBG-R funds. The Town Hall improvement project has been completed with the handrails being installed by the approved contractor, McHugh Iron &amp; Steel Inc. of Detroit, MI and had a total cost of \$13,023.08. The San Jose Street Sewer Relining project bid was completed during this reporting period and a contract was signed on June 17, 2010 with the approved contractor, Inland Waters Pollution Control. This project will also be leveraging funds from our CDBG Program and will have a total project budget of approx. \$120,000.00. The CDBG-R portion of the sewer improvements will be \$25,000. The sewer relining work will be completed during the next reporting period. The Youth Services project funded staffing during this reporting period in the amount of \$2,009.41 and numerous programs/activities were completed and supervision was provided by Township youth services.
