<b>Award Description</b> Redford Township, Michigan is an Entitlement Grantee in the HUD Program. Under ARRA 2009, our Township has been allocated \$261,229 in CDBG-R funds, which are supplemental to our regular CDBG program. Redford Township will utilize the CDBG-R funds to support a broad range of housing and community development projects that are "shovel-ready" that can be implemented as soon as possible. Redford Township has proposed 10 activities using CDBG-R funds. All non-planning and administrative funds will either benefit low and moderate income persons or areas that are considered by HUD to be low and moderate income areas.

<p><b>Quarterly Activities/ Project Description</b></p> <p>Two capital improvement projects have been undertaken by Redford Township during this reporting period using CDBG-R funds. The ADA sidewalk improvement project has been substantially completed and had \$49,206.40 disbursed for this project. Coleman Cmeemet Company of Redford Township, MI was awarded this contract and completed 124 ADA handicap curb cut ramps throughout a CDBG eligible residential neighborhood. The ADA Town Hall improvement project has also been substantially completed and utilized \$48,684.60 in funds. Qualified Construction Corporation of Wixom, MI was awarded this contract and they removed &amp; installed new concrete walkways, ADA handicap curb cuts and an ADA handicap accessible ramp at our municipal building/complex. In addition, installation of ADA handrails and lighting is pending.</p> <p>UPCOMING PROJECTS: Funding for Housing Rehabilitation will be used in the coming months for energy efficient improvements to residential single-family homes to low-moderate income households. Sewer Improvement project will begin in the Spring of 2010, with bids being prepared mid-winter 2010 and work to commence in the Spring.
