The approved contractor, Corby Energy Services of Belleville, MI signed their contract on October 25, 2010. Corby Energy began the project in December 2010 and should have a completion date of January 2011. In addition, Redford Interfaith Relief was allocated \$10,000 for additional staffing at their facility in the Pearson Education Center. RIR has had a significant increase in individuals/families seeking assistance through their various programs (i.e. food pantry, clothing, aid, etc.) The additional staffing was needed to input data, distribution of food/clothing, assist volunteers/staff, and build relationships with local agencies to meet the growing demand for assistance within our community.
