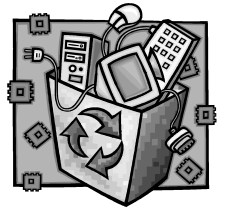

*****These collection sites are open to all Wayne County residents & proof of County residency will be required. Please note that Redford will not be holding its own Household Hazardous Waste event this year and is encouraging Township residents to participate in one offered by the County.**

EXAMPLES OF ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

HOUSEHOLD - Floor care products, waxes, furniture polishes, stain removers, carpet cleaners, bathroom cleaners, bug sprays, solvents, nail polish, drain openers/cleaners, oven cleaners, paints/primers, dyes/stains, batteries (*dry-cell*), glues, aerosols, moth balls, dry cleaning solvents, lighter fluids, mercury thermometers

GARAGE - Transmission & brake fluids, motor oils, anti-freeze, gasoline, waxes, metal polish, auto batteries, paints, fiberglass epoxy

LAWN & GARDEN - Fungicides, herbicides, insecticides, pesticides, fertilizers, weed killers, rat poison

WORKSHOP - Fluorescent & CFL bulbs (all types), paints & primers, paint thinner, strippers, turpentine, varnishes, wood preservatives, stains/dyes, glues

PHARMACEUTICAL WASTE - Sharps (*medical needles in metal or plastic containers*), expired medicines (*non-controlled substances only*)

ELECTRONICS RECYCLING - Computer CPUs, monitors, printers, scanners, keyboards & mouse, copiers, fax machines, TVs, cell & house phones

MISCELLANEOUS - Artists' paints/mediums, photo chemicals, pool chemicals, gun cleaning solvents, acids, small propane cylinders, smoke detectors, fire extinguishers, elemental mercury, mercury thermometers, thermostats

NON-ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Commercial or industrial generated wastes
- Radioactive materials
- Refrigerators, microwaves or other appliances
- Shock sensitive materials
- Yard Waste
- Concrete
- Ammunition
- Household trash
- Tires
- Explosives
- 55 gallon drums

Only household generated products from Wayne County residents will be accepted. A valid driver's license or other ID must be shown to verify Wayne County residency.
