The Charter Township of Redford and the Redford Township Police and Fire Civil Service Commission are accepting applications for the position of Police Officer for the purpose of establishing an eligibility list.

Starting salary is \$39,732 with top pay being \$58,862 after five years. Family health insurance is offered through Blue Cross/Blue Shield HSA with the deductible funded by the Township. Both optical and dental coverage is provided. We also offer defined benefit retirement.

The Department currently consists of a Chief, three Captains, four Lieutenants, six Sergeants, 42 Police Officers, seven dispatchers, and five civilian support staff.

Applicants must have sixty (60) semester hours or ninety (90) quarter hours of college credit, graduated from the police academy or be a student within 2 months of graduation and be an MCOLES certified or certifiable police officer (upon graduation from the police academy).

Only completed applications will be considered. Additionally, you must pass the written test with EMPCO, Inc. and have selected Redford Township on the EMPCO website by February 28, 2017.

As necessary, candidates meeting all testing and application requirements will be invited to interview with an oral board. Candidates should also be prepared to undergo a comprehensive background investigation, complete a physical with drug screen and psychological examination. Chosen applicants must meet all MCOLES requirements, complete a Field Training Program and a one year probationary period.

All qualified applicants will receive consideration for employment without regard to race, color, religions, sex, national origin or disability. Individuals with disabilities should request reasonable accommodations in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act prior to testing.
