


PROCLAMATION


Honoring GEORGE ALBERT DuVALL


- WHEREAS,** George Albert DuVall was born on May 26, 1922 and served in the Navy from November 1942 to November 1945 when he was honorable discharged as "Ship's Cook 2nd Class; and,
- WHEREAS,** George Albert DuVall joined and became an Annual member of VFW Post 345 on October 12, 1943 while still serving in the Navy; and,
- WHEREAS,** George Albert DuVall served as Post Commander from 1948-49 and became a Life Member of VFW Post 345 on September 3, 1970; and,
- WHEREAS,** George Albert DuVall joined the Military Order of the Cootie (Pup Tent 21) in 1949 and has served many positions, including Seam Squirrel (same as Post Commander, but of the Cooties). Currently he is the CCDB (Crummy Custodian of the Duffel Bag) and has been for at least 30 years. This Auxiliary's primary mission is the care and welfare of disabled veterans; and,
- WHEREAS,** George Albert DuVall became a Life Member of the VFW's Nation Home for Children in March of 1957 whose facility in Eaton Rapids Michigan is designed to take care of our widows and orphans of Veterans; and,
- WHEREAS,** George Albert DuVall has served on the Post Building Committee on and off for many years. He was very instrumental in securing the property, bank loan, and the construction of the current building. He continues to offer his support and advice on most every activity or project that involves the Post; and,
- WHEREAS,** George Albert DuVall is the Post Historian, Officer of the Day, Judge Advocate, Post Cook and held many other support roles over the last 66 plus years as the longest serving active member of the Post. His fellow veterans describe him as "in a league of his own" for always putting the post and the VFW ahead of any one person or group and is known for being a work hard-play hard type and always fun to be around.







