

- 1) AMBULANCE: a vehicle equipped for transporting the injured or sick
- 2) ARENA: an enclosed area used for public entertainment
- 3) CLERK: an official responsible for correspondence, records and vested with specific powers
- 4) COMMISSIONER: a resident appointed and given authority to represent the citizens on a specific subject.
- 5) COURT: an official assembly for the transaction of judicial business
- 6) ELECTION: to make the selection by vote for offices and questions
- 7) FIREFIGHTER: one who fights fires
- 8) JUDGE: a public official authorized to decide questions brought before a court
- 9) ORDINANCE: a law set forth by a governmental authority
- 10) PARKS: a piece of ground in a town kept for ornamental or recreational purposes
- 11) POLICE: the department of government concerned primarily with the maintenance of public order
- 12) RECREATION: to create, restore, refresh
- 13) RESOLUTION: a formal expression of opinion, will, or intent voted by an official body
- 14) SANITATION: disposal of waste and redistribution of recycling
- 15) SUPERVISOR: an administrative office in charge of township government
- 16) TOWNSHIP: a unit of local government
- 17) TREASURER: a governmental official in charge of the collection, management and expenditures
- 18) TRUSTEE: a governmental official elected to represent the residents regarding matters concerning the community
- 19) VOLUNTEER: one who enters into or offers oneself for a service of their own free will
- 20) WATER: the liquid that is a major constituent of all living matter
