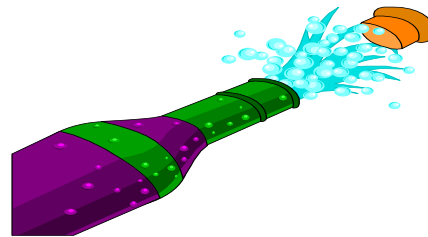

## Need a Passport?

The Clerk's Office is a passport acceptance facility and if you will need one, stop by and see us. Bring two passport photographs, your government issued (raised seal) birth certificate or naturalization papers and picture identification (State Identification Card or Drivers License). We will process your application at the cost of \$67.00 in a check made out to the Department of State and \$30.00 cash for the execution fee. The Department of State expects to process an application within six weeks time.

Clerk's office hours for passports are 9am – 4pm,

Monday through Friday.

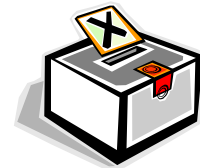
## August 2, 2005 Election
