1. Approval of Minutes

2. Annual Redford Jaycees' Kelly Miller Circus, at Bell Creek Park on August 8, 2008, tent raising by elephants open to public at 8:30 a.m. and two shows; one at 4:30 and 7:30 p.m.
3. Bids will be accepted until 3:00 p.m. on July 31, 2008 and then read at that time for Vinyl Siding and Trim Wrap on Minock Meadow Senior Housing.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Agreement to Accept Personal Representative's Deed to property located at 26704 Five Mile Road (#79-019-02-0001-000) in Lieu of Foreclosure, Township will pay property taxes currently owing on property (\$4,970.62 in back taxes with penalty if paid before 7/31/08), and Personal Representative will provide Letters of Authority evidencing his ability to Transfer Marketable Title and submit to Minnesota Title Agency any other documents required.
2. Permission to proceed with Contested Case Hearing along with other communities within the County to express concerns regarding the new MDEQ requirements for issuance of a new storm water permit.
3. 1st Reading to Amend Section 58-252 of Code Ordinance to make it unlawful to possess in a public place any air gun, slingshot, bows and arrows, or other similar dangerous weapon unless carried unloaded or carried in a suitable case or securely wrapped up in a package.
4. 1st Reading to Amend Section 58-296 of Code Ordinance to make it illegal to furnish any tobacco product in any form to any person under the age of 18.
5. 1st Reading to Amend Section 58-303(d)(2) of Code Ordinance to change the time period for the rebuttable presumption that a minor who commits a delinquent act after a parent is given notice pursuant to § 58-303(c) has done so with the knowledge, allowance, permission or sufferance of the parent from 45 days to 90 days.
6. 1st Reading of a new Ordinance to make unlawful the keeping, harboring, owning, or possessing any vicious dog; to require registration of vicious dogs already kept within the Township; requiring identification, license fee, control, reporting; and establishing penalty and continuing violation.
7. 1st Reading of a new Ordinance to make it unlawful for a person who is responsible for the care or welfare of a child to leave that child unattended in a vehicle for a period of time that poses an unreasonable risk of harm or injury to the child, to make such violation a misdemeanor, and to repeal any ordinance in conflict.
8. Authorization to prepare a Special Warrant List of Bills on 7/16/08 and pay on 7/25/08.
