Trustee Fleming wished Trustee Kobylarz a "Happy 47th birthday today.


Trustee Kobylarz announced that Friday, June 13th will be their 22nd wedding anniversary and she said "thank you for staying married to me".

His priority will be local revenue sharing as well as community colleges and our voices will be heard. At a meeting earlier today they discussed doing analyses for local governments on what the decline in property values mean to their budgets. He said he had the privilege of meeting with Supervisor Handy and various sponsors for the fireworks event and the reception was very strong and positive, and he looks forward to a great show on July 2nd.
