- 1.) 2024-2025 Budget: - Discussion on 2024-2025 budget, Director Stokes went over line items within the budget and Capital Improvements from the Master plan. Commissioners would like to see from previous discussions the possibilities of improvements to tennis courts at Handy Park, the expansion of the Splashpad and walking trails. The priorities would be changing the courts at Handy to pickleball and see about costs of resurfacing the tennis courts at Claude Allison. There is \$750,000 from the state funds, Director Stokes is looking on the timeline for that to be spent, we will also be getting the add alt to the Recreation Center amphitheater with those bids to decide if the Commission is able to fund that project. Budget discussion will continue in the regular meeting as well due to time.
